

NHS Covid vaccine Scam

Several reports are circulating of people being contacted by fraudsters offering the Covid19 vaccine. The reports show text messages being sent providing a link for people to register their details to apply for the vaccine, some of which require payment.

These text messages and links are not sent from, or linked to, the NHS.

When you are eligible for the vaccine you will be contacted by your GP. NHS and other frontline staff will be contacted directly by your employer.

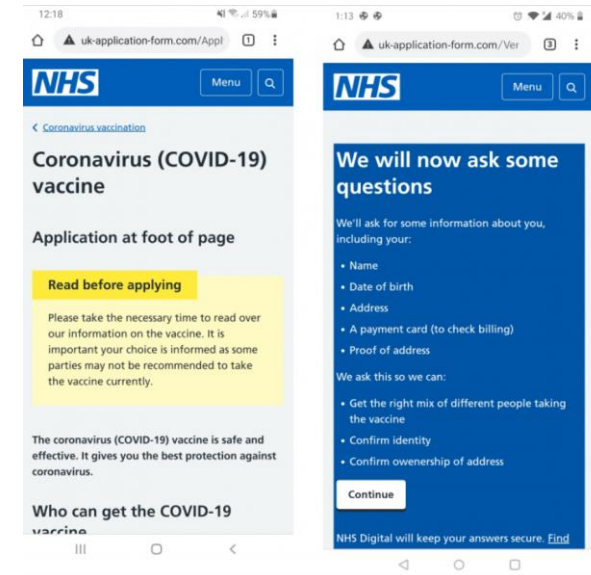
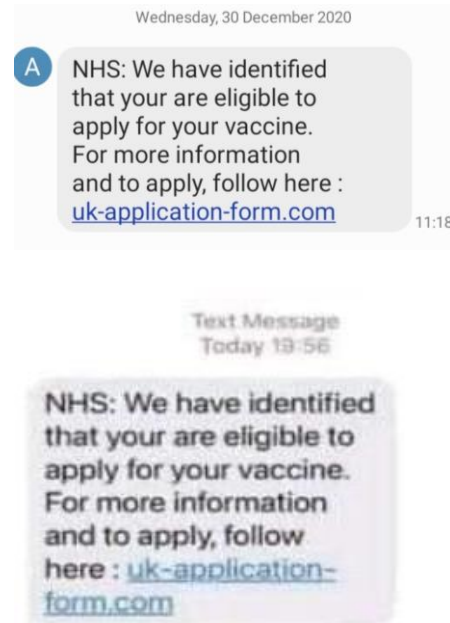
The NHS will:

- NEVER ask you to press a button on your keypad or send a text asking you to confirm you want the **vaccine**.
- NEVER ask for payment for the **vaccine** or for your bank details.

If you receive a text message from an unfamiliar number:

- Do not respond to it or click on any links
- Do not enter any personal or log on details
- Do not make any payment
